RESOLUTION
OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF TUOLUMNE

- WHEREAS,** Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and
- WHEREAS,** SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and
- WHEREAS,** the County must adopt by resolution a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and
- WHEREAS,** the County, will receive and estimated \$2,372,480 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2018-19 from SB 1; and
- WHEREAS,** this is the second year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and
- WHEREAS,** the County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate 610 centerline miles of streets/roads, 54 bridges, add active transportation infrastructure throughout the County this year and hundreds of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are in an "poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "at-risk" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Tuolumne hereby supports Proposition 69 on the June 2018 ballot to prevent new transportation funds from being diverted for non-transportation purposes; and that the County of Tuolumne hereby supports Proposition 69, the June 2018 constitutional amendment to prevent new transportation funds from being diverted for non-transportation purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of Supervisors of the County, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
